Special Notes: There are numerous sensitive ecosystems within the park. Please be respectful of the natural area.

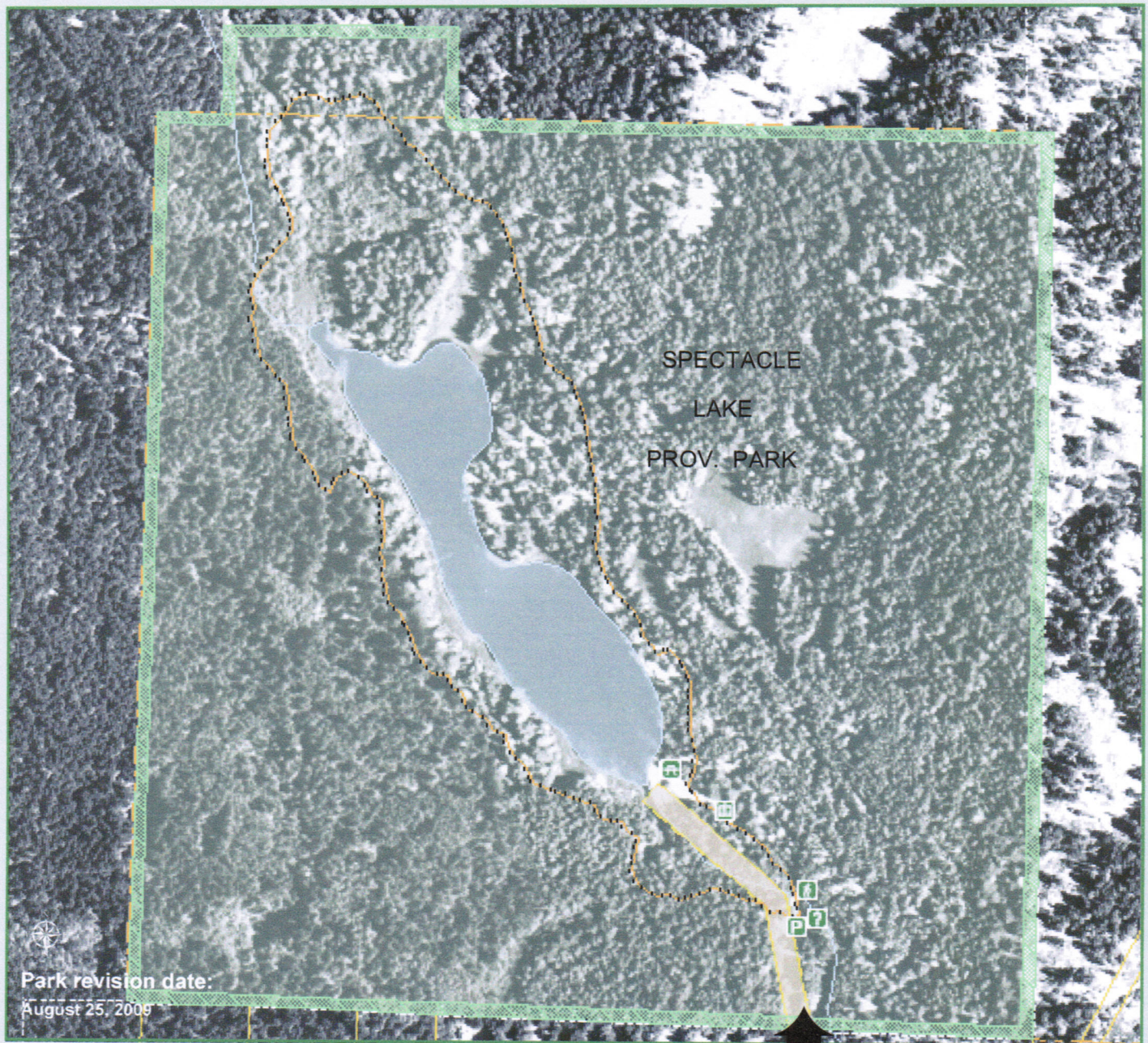
Amenities: Lake amenities include a beach, swimming, a picnic area, trails, and toilet facilities.
